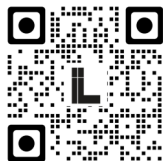
Check out the courses offered this semester, register for your choices, and join us for an experience of becoming a learner for life. We always welcome recommendations for course offerings and instructors.

Prayer: Conversation and Communion with God

Christianity Comes to America—a Protestant Story

How did we get here?

In this class, we explore the history of the American Protestant Church from the 1600s to Lakeway Church in 2023. Our class will study the spread of what has been called “the Seven Sisters of American Protestantism,” more commonly known as the mainline denominations, on their journey across our country’s broad landscape. We then will follow four periods of renewal and revival, often called “awakenings,” that give insight into the last 400 years of the church in the United States. These unique periods have shaped and formed not only the church, but also the whole of U.S. culture. Finally, we will land on the doorstep of Lakeway Church as we explore the unique expression of church life called “non-denominational.” Join us for this fascinating exploration of God’s work in the United States and the impact of church life on our country. Six 90-minute sessions beginning October 16.
